About MRI

Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) is increasingly being used in diagnosis of stroke, spine, sport injury and body etc. It has no radiation and is highly sensitive. With the advantages of high image contrast resolution and the development of new imaging sequences, the new generation wide bore MRI scanner gives excellent quality images and the increased bore goes around the patient in respect to a narrow bore. This not only accommodates the claustrophobic but also helps large size and obese patients.

There is no special preparation required for the scan. Before the scan, our medical staff will give a brief explanation of the procedures to the patient and the patient also need to ask to fill a consent form regarding to their clinical history (e.g. pregnancy and allergic history) and to make sure there is no unnecessary metal (e.g. ear ring, removable dentures) or electronic device (e.g. pacemaker) in their body. Those will degrade image quality and lead to unnecessary hazard to patient.

During MRI scan, patient lie on a flat couch that will move into scanner. The scan usually lasts for 30 to 45 mins. Due to rapid change of magnetic fields, the machine will produce noise in different tones, so ear plugs or headset will be provided.
